DOWNTOWN • SOUTH SIDE • NORTHSIDE

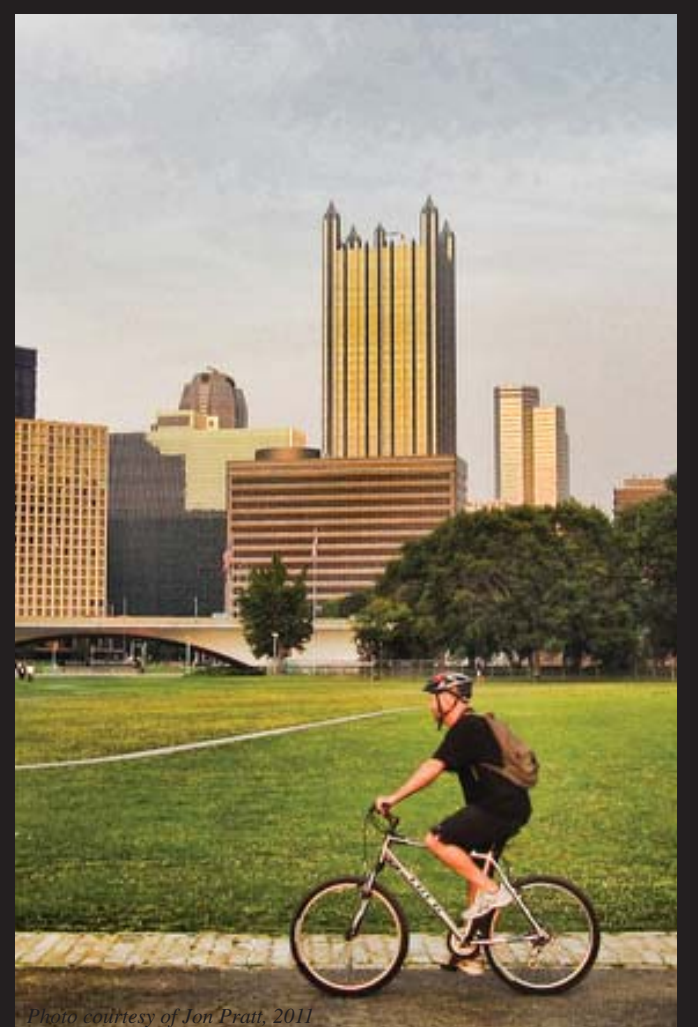
